Be sure to include:

- 1) **Check for \$275 (\$255 for USS members, # _____) payable to TSRC. If entering after July 15, 2009, the entry fee is \$305 (\$285 for USS members).** No entries after July 25, 2009.
- 2) **Check for \$85, payable to GLSS. If entering after July 15, 2009, the entry fee is \$105. Note - Entries received after July 15, 2009 may be rejected due to insufficient time to review qualifications.**
- 3) Proof of liability insurance covering the period of the event.
- 4) Completed two page "Sailing Experience Resume" form. Not required for GLSS members.
- 5) Completed "Documentation of Solo Passage" form. This 100 mile/24 hour solo under sail must be completed before July 28, 2009 but still must be approved prior to acceptance into the Singlehanded Division. Not required for GLSS members.
- 6) Life raft inspection certification by an approved servicing agent within **40 months prior to the event** date. Note that this is a revision from the fully crewed Trans Superior requirement of 48 months. Also note that any multihull that wishes to substitute an anti-exposure suit for the life raft requirement must submit a completed "Anti-Exposure Suit Certificate" with their entry.
- 7) **For monohulls:** PHRF rating certificate from a recognized rating association. Note that some adjustments may be made due to the variance of rating associations on the Great Lakes. Skippers will be assessed a 6 second/mile penalty if they enter without a valid PHRF certificate issued within the previous 3 years. If no certificate is available submit a completed "Request for Singlehanded Rating" form.
- 8) **For Multihulls:** GLMRA (Great Lakes Multihull Rating Association) rating certificate. If no certificate is available submit a completed "Request for Singlehanded Rating" form.

Note: No roller furling credits will be allowed.

You will be notified via email of your acceptance in the Challenge as soon as the GLSS Board of Directors has had an opportunity to review your application. You will be writing two checks, one payable to the TSRC in the amount of \$275 (\$255 for US Sailing Members – add the US Sailing number on your check). Please make the other check payable to “GLSS” in the amount of \$85. Note that these amounts are for normal entries only – if you are entering late, please submit a check for \$305 to TSRC, and \$105 to GLSS. If you do wish to purchase an additional medallion, please submit an additional \$30, and check the box below. Please ensure that you have provided a valid, legible email address on your entry form.
